

New Fellowship awards announced

Since its relaunch in 2016, the Bill Raby Diabetes Fellowship has awarded **\$117,000 in funding** to **48 community groups and individuals**.



2023 funding update

The Fellowship Board of Governors approved the award of funding grants to organisations in the December 2023 funding round. These include:

\$2,956 to the Central Australian Aboriginal Alcohol Programmes Unit

for the purchase of new exercise equipment for rehabilitation clients.

\$4,925 to CatholicCare Resources Ltd

to support the establishment of a **School Breakfast and Lunch Program** for the 15 Mile Community in Darwin.

Applications to the Fellowship are considered twice a year with the next round **closing on 31 May 2024**. Applications are now open in the following categories:

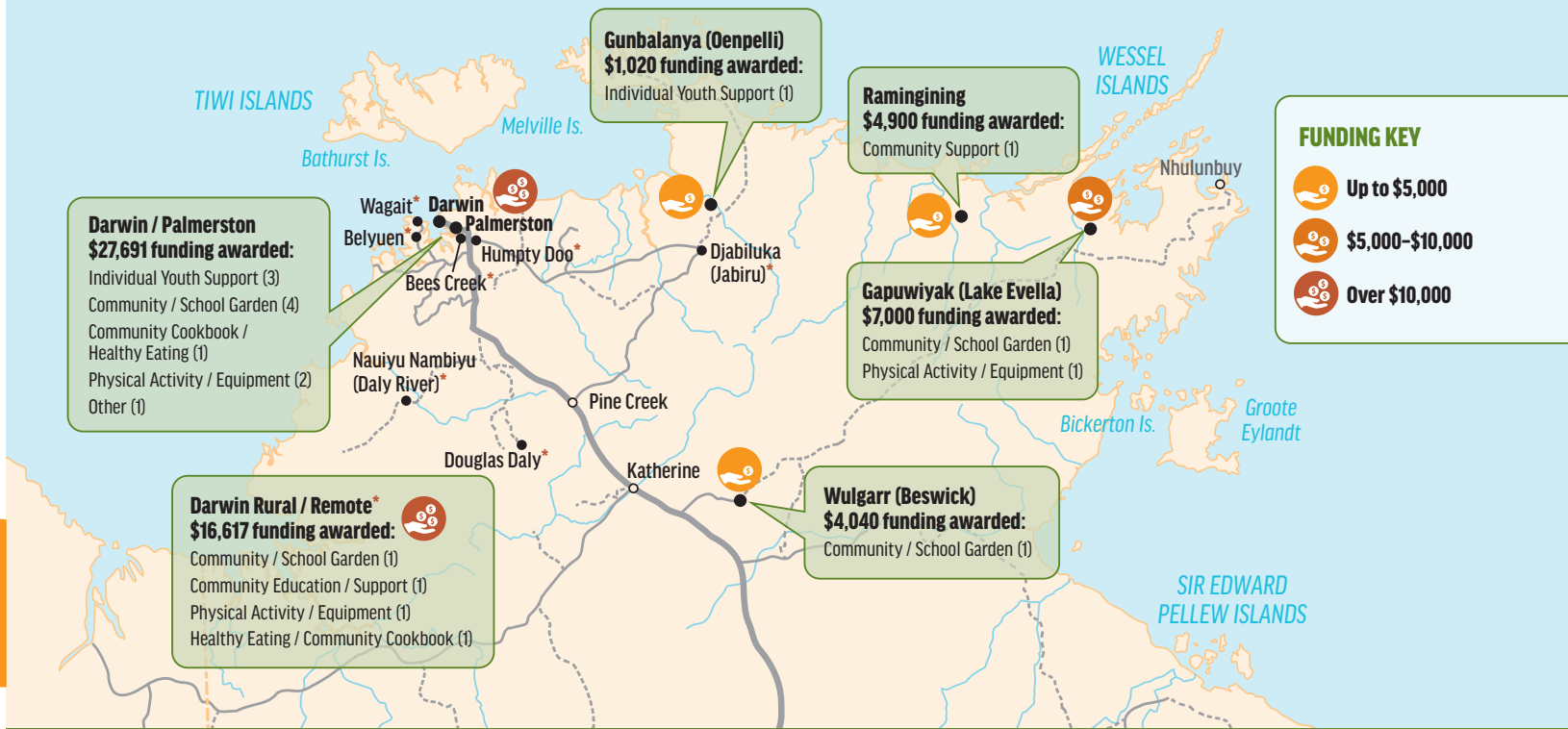


Aquaponic System Malak Primary School

They harvested spinach for pesto, shared insights during Science Week, and explored interdisciplinary connections.

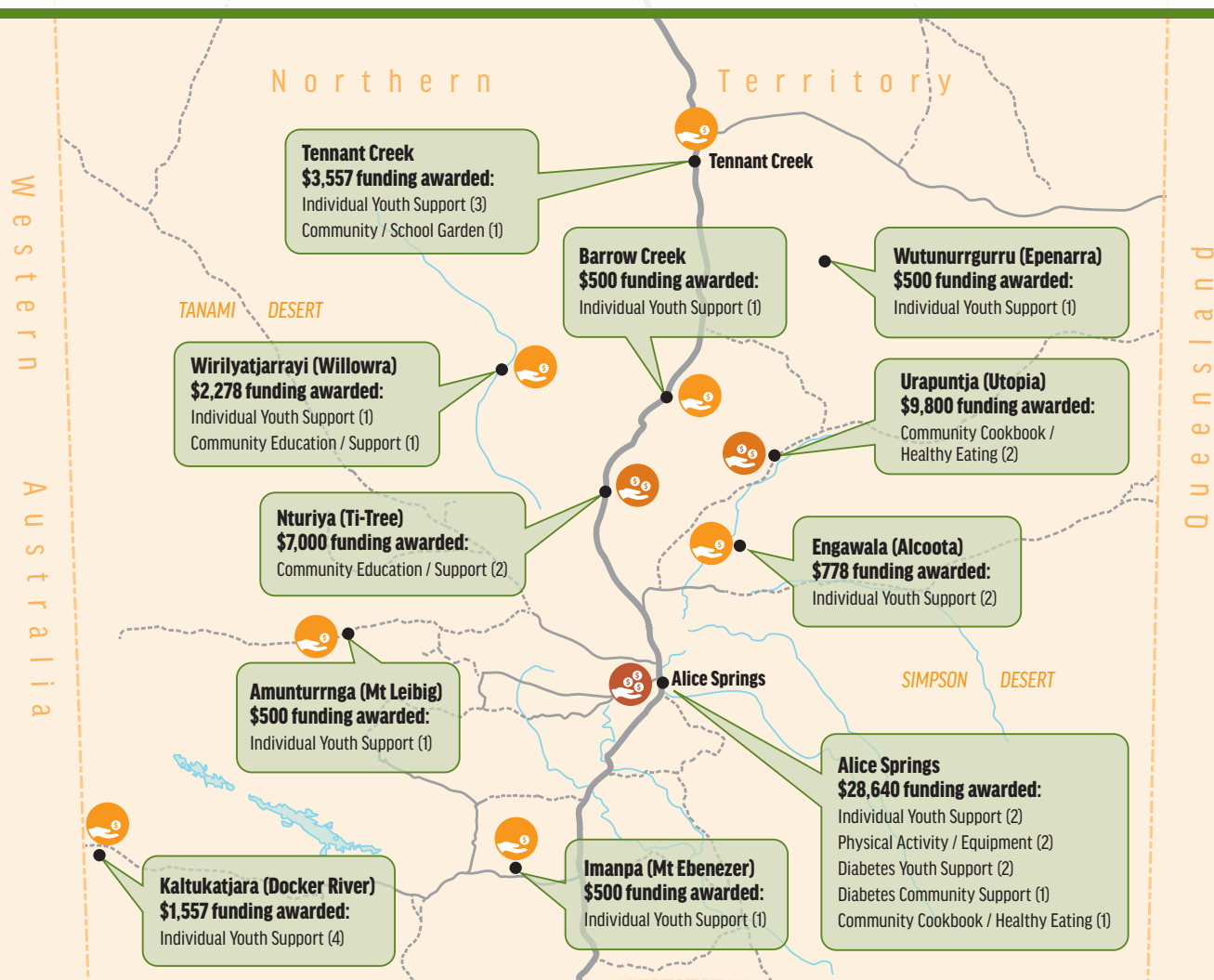
