Single Use Lancets (medical use only)

Please note: You may be given a single use lancet from a hospital or clinic to get you started with monitoring. Single use lancets are designed for use in a medical setting to reduce needle stick injury occurring to clinical staff. For this reason, single use lancets are significantly more expensive and therefore not recommended for use by clients with diabetes on an everyday basis.
